We very much are looking forward to an exciting year!



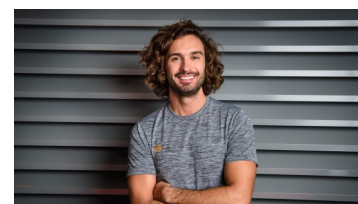
## Community learning - Friday
